


WHERE TO EAT

CHEZ HUGO

FOR SOMETHING A LITTLE MORE REFINED, CHEZ HUGO IS A TINY BUT FANTASTIC SPOT IN THE HEART OF THE VILLAGE. THE CHEF CREATES BEAUTIFUL, SEASONAL DISHES THAT MIX TRADITIONAL PROVENÇAL FLAVOURS WITH A MODERN TOUCH. THE MENU CHANGES OFTEN, BUT WHATEVER’S ON IT—it’s always worth it.

LA GLOIRE DE MON PÈRE

RUSTIC, COZY, AND ALL ABOUT BIG, COMFORTING FLAVOURS. NAMED AFTER MARCEL PAGNOL’S FAMOUS NOVEL, THIS SPOT SERVES UP HEARTY PROVENÇAL CLASSICS AROUND THE FOUNTAIN ON PLACE DU THOURON.

THINGS TO DO

WANDER THROUGH "VIEUX BARGEMON"

THE OLDEST PART OF THE VILLAGE, VIEUX BARGEMON, IS A MAZE OF NARROW ALLEYWAYS, HIDDEN COURTYARDS, AND CHARMING STONE HOUSES. JUST GET LOST AND SEE WHERE THE STREETS TAKE YOU—YOU'LL FIND LITTLE SURPRISES AROUND EVERY CORNER.

PEEK INSIDE NOTRE-DAME DE BARGEMON

THIS QUIET LITTLE CHURCH IS WORTH A VISIT, IF ONLY TO SEE ITS SAINT WHO LOOKS LIKE SHE STEPPED STRAIGHT OUT OF A DISNEY FAIRYTALE.

BARGEMON HAS AN EASYGOING, LIVED-IN CHARM. IT'S A PLACE WHERE LOCALS GREET EACH OTHER BY NAME, THE BAKERY SELLS OUT BEFORE NOON, AND THE DAYS ARE BEST SPENT DOING VERY LITTLE—JUST HOW IT SHOULD BE.

THE PROVENÇAL MARKET

FAYENCE COMES ALIVE ON MARKET DAYS—TUESDAY, THURSDAY, AND SATURDAY—with Saturday being the biggest and most vibrant. You'll find everything from flowy dresses and Panama hats to baskets of sun-ripened olives, fragrant herbs, and freshly baked bread. In summer, it's best to go early while the air is still cool, and parking is easy at the Super U parking lot.

A SLOW MORNING

START THE DAY AT **BAR DES CAMPAGNES** ON THE MAIN SQUARE WITH A STRONG COFFEE AND A FLAKY CROISSANT, AND VISIT THE MARKET.

FROM THERE, TAKE A SLOW WANDER THROUGH THE OLD TOWN, GETTING LOST IN ITS QUIET ALLEYWAYS. A QUICK STOP AT **ÉGLISE SAINT-JEAN-BAPTISTE** IS A MUST—THIS 18TH-CENTURY CHURCH IS SIMPLE YET BEAUTIFUL, WITH STUNNING VIEWS OVER THE VALLEY.

LUNCH & WINE

FOR LUNCH, SETTLE IN AT **LE TEMPS DES CERISES** OR **LE FRANCE**, BOTH SERVING NICE REGIONAL CUISINE WITH A RELAXED AMBIANCE. IF YOU'RE PLANNING A PICNIC OR JUST WANT TO BRING HOME SOME NICE WINES, STOP BY **LA CAVE DE FAYENCE** FOR A SELECTION OF LOCAL WINES.

NEAR FAYENCE

LE GRAND JARDIN

ON SELECT DATES, THIS CHARMING SPOT HOSTS A BROCANTE AND ANTIQUE MARKET. IT'S ALSO A LOVELY PLACE TO STOP FOR A COFFEE OR AN APÉRITIF AT THE RESTAURANT.

BOULANGERIE MAISON SARROCHE



PICK UP STREET SNACKS LIKE PISSALADIÈRE (A PIZZA-LIKE CARAMELISED ONION TART) AND TOURTE DE BLETTES (CHARD, RAISIN AND PINE NUT PIE) AS YOU GO, THEN SETTLE IN FOR A LUNCH OF SMALL PLATES AT LAVOMATIQUE, A MUCH-TALKED ABOUT FORMER LAUNDRETTE TURNED CONTEMPORARY RESTAURANT RUN BY BROTHERS HUGO AND GRÉGOIRE LOCALES AND HAUTE-CLASS FINE DINING. COME THE EVENING, CHOOSE FROM A HANDFUL OF COSY, FAMILY-RUN RESTAURANTS LIKE CHEZ DAVIA, OR OPT FOR UNSTUFFY MICHELIN-STAR FARE AT NEO-BISTRO LES AGITATEURS.
